# **Engaging the Online and Blended Learner Class 2**

#### **Course Description**

This course is designed for educators who are interested in learning new ways to engage learners in an online/blended environment. Participants will become familiar with iNACOL (International Association for K-12 Online Learning) teaching standards and how to apply them into their curriculum and delivery methods. Educators are challenged to implement blended/online procedures in their classrooms by providing them with technology based education platforms. Teachers will become familiar with the technological skills to provide online feedback and student interaction in a blended and online classroom.

- Explore best practices for engaging students online.
- Analyze which blended or online model could be used in your classroom.
- Develop an online program for their educational goals.
